FINANCIAL GUIDELINES FOR GRANTS

To determine your need, take your adjusted gross income (found on the first page of your federal income tax return) and subtract out-of-pocket medical expenses for the child in the past year. Compare your final outcome to our table below.

CLINICAL AND EQUIPMENT GRANTS

Number of dependent children	Qualifying income cannot exceed
1	\$30,000
2	\$45,000
3	\$70,000
4	\$85,000
5	\$100,000

VEHICLE AND TRANSPORTATION MODIFICATION/REPLACEMENT GRANT

Annual Family Income	Maximum Grant Amount
\$0.00 up to \$30,000	\$4,500
\$25,000 up to \$35,000	\$2,500

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TRAVEL AND LODGING GRANTS

Annual Family Income	Maximum Grant Amount
\$0.00 up to \$20,000	\$1,000
\$20,000 up to \$35,000	\$750
\$35,000 up to \$50,000	\$450

Expenses covered:

- Treatment: Clinical procedures, medicine, therapy, prosthesis, etc.
- Equipment: Wheelchairs, assistive technology equipment, care devices, hearing aids, etc.
- Displacement: Lodging (only if charitable housing is unavailable), gas (\$0.33 per mile), parking and transportation related to a child's care
- Vehicle modifications: Lifts, ramps and transfer boards

Expenses not covered:

- Home modification projects
- Alternative or experimental drugs, treatment or therapy where there is controversy in the medical community
- Wheelchair-accessible van purchases
- Requests for research funding, mass population grants or other not-for-profit organizational grants
- Requests for debt reduction/past medical bills
- Copays or deductibles
- Therapy dogs or any animals
